The Purchasing Department received questions relating to the above referenced Bid.

- 1. When do you plan on starting this Project?
 The bid opens on the 06-26-07, possibly by the end of July.
- 2. Do you need to file the CIQ forms on every bid?

 The only time you need to file a new CIQ form is when the people review the bid has change or the department.
- 3. In the spec's you want to minimize the pedestrian interruptions can this work be done at night time?

Yes, the vendor may work at night; however, the vendor must take in to consideration that they will not have access to electrical power after 6:00 p.m. if it is run from inside the Courthouse, as is usually the case. If the vendor can operate at night with an alternative to power, and will not need access to the inside of the Courthouse, and will not violate any City ordinances relating to noise, disruption, etc. the vendor may work at night. Also, if there will be any additional charges that are directly

related to working at night that would not be customary if the same work was completed during the day, the vendor should include this in the total cost of the project when the bid is submitted.

- 4. On the scope of work do we remove just the topping of the concrete? This is the 1st phase we want to minimize the damage to the concrete underneath.
- 5. When we remove the concrete underneath and we encounter bad areas are we suppose to bring to your attention?

- 6. The specs indicate 42, 000 sq ft is that correct? Yes.
- 7. Can we each measure the sq ft?
