## The following is a recap of the pre-bid conference held on Thursday, July 26, 2018:

1. How will employee vetting/background checks be conducted?

RESPONSE: Employee background checks will be conducted through U.S. Customs and Border Protection.

2. Is there a Geological report?

RESPONSE: No geotechnical analysis was performed specifically for this project. For this project, the County of El Paso has accepted the general geotechnical report performed by Licon Engineering entitled, "Geotechnical Engineering Study Tornillo/Guadalupe International Bridge, El Paso, TX," dated April 09, 2003.

3. Will suppliers need to go through background checks as well?

RESPONSE: Yes, all employees, subcontractors, drivers, etc., must pass the background check and vetting to be allowed onto the worksite.

4. Where will the employee parking be located?

**RESPONSE:** Anyone with a vehicle entering the worksite may park in the area.

5. Will awarded vendor need to give access to the worksite to Border Patrol Agents? Will they be passing by?

RESPONSE: It is likely that Agents will be around the worksite. Although there may be ramps that can allow them to go around the site, the awarded vendor must fully cooperate with and give access to Border Patrol Agents.
