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### **The Purchasing Department has received the following questions:**

1. Is this a design or construction project? For what phase is this solicitation?

**RESPONSE: This is a bid request for the construction of the Ascarate park lift station and sanitary sewer improvements and should be built as per plans.**

2. Is there a plan holders or bidders list available and how can the vendors confirm that the bid date and time are unchanged?

**RESPONSE: Information regarding this and any other bid can be found on the County's website: [www.epcounty.com](http://www.epcounty.com) Select: Directory, Purchasing, List of Bids.**

3. Drawing C-7 shows new lift station along with Spec Section 02530 Grinder Pump Unit. Is there information on the plans showing power source & electrical requirements for the lift station?

**RESPONSE: Sanitary Sewer Detailed View, on sheet C-3, indicates that electrical power should be extended from existing meter located adjacent to existing abandoned lift station. Existing power available is 230v/60hz/1 phase. Proposed lift station power requirements are 120/240v, 60 hz, 1 phase.**

4. Is there a cost estimate or budget released for this project and is there estimated start/end dates for this project?

**RESPONSE: There is no cost estimate at this time. The project shall be started as soon as it is approved and awarded by the Court.**

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**The following is a recap of the pre-bid conference held on Thursday, February 13, 2020:**

1. Will there be a Geotech test done by the owner or the contractor?

**RESPONSE: The density test will be done by the owner.**

2. Are the facilities currently functional?

**RESPONSE: No, they are completely shut down.**

3. Is the sanitation contract not going to take place?

**RESPONSE: Once the project is complete, sanitation will continue.**
