



HOLIDAY LEAVE



In accordance with the County's Holiday Policy: In the event a holiday falls on Sunday, the following Monday shall be deemed to be the holiday. In the event the holiday falls on Saturday, the preceding Friday shall be deemed to be the holiday. In the event the scheduled holiday shall be moved to either a Friday or Monday and that day is already observed as another County holiday, the scheduled holiday shall be given on the next available business day. Therefore, the holidays for this fiscal year are as follows:

- COLUMBUS DAY:** Monday, October 8, 2018
- VETERANS DAY:** Monday, November 12, 2018 (Observed)
- THANKSGIVING DAY:** Thursday, November 22, 2018
- DAY AFTER THANKSGIVING:** Friday, November 23, 2018
- CHRISTMAS EVE:** Monday, December 24, 2018
- CHRISTMAS DAY:** Tuesday, December 25, 2018
- NEW YEAR'S EVE:** Monday, December 31, 2018
- NEW YEAR'S DAY:** Tuesday, January 1, 2019
- MARTIN LUTHER KING DAY:** Monday, January 21, 2019
- PRESIDENT'S DAY:** Monday, February 18, 2019
- CESAR CHAVEZ DAY:** Monday, April 1, 2019 (Observed)
- GOOD FRIDAY:** Friday, April 19, 2019
- MEMORIAL DAY:** Monday, May 27, 2019
- JUNETEENTH:** Wednesday, June 19, 2019
- INDEPENDENCE DAY:** Thursday, July 4, 2019
- LABOR DAY:** Monday, September 2, 2019
