



# El Paso County Holiday Leave



In accordance with the County's Holiday Policy: In the event a holiday falls on Sunday, the following Monday shall be deemed to be the holiday. In the event the holiday falls on Saturday, the preceding Friday shall be deemed to be the holiday. In the event the scheduled holiday shall be moved to either a Friday or Monday and that day is already observed as another County holiday, the scheduled holiday shall be given on the next available business day. Therefore, the holidays for this fiscal year are as follows:

- **INDIGENOUS PEOPLES DAY:** Monday, October 9, 2023
- **VETERANS DAY:** Friday, November 10, 2023 (Observed)
- **THANKSGIVING DAY:** Thursday, November 23, 2023
- **DAY AFTER THANKSGIVING:** Friday, November 24, 2023
- **CHRISTMAS EVE:** Monday, December 25, 2023
- **CHRISTMAS DAY:** Tuesday, December 26, 2023 (Observed)
- **NEW YEAR'S EVE:** Monday, January 1, 2024
- **NEW YEAR'S DAY:** Tuesday, January 2, 2024 (Observed)
- **MARTIN LUTHER KING DAY:** Monday, January 15, 2024
- **PRESIDENT'S DAY:** Monday, February 19, 2024
- **GOOD FRIDAY:** Friday, March 29, 2024
- **CESAR CHAVEZ DAY:** Monday, April 1, 2024
- **MEMORIAL DAY:** Monday, May 27, 2024
- **JUNETEENTH:** Wednesday, June 19, 2024
- **INDEPENDENCE DAY:** Thursday, July 4, 2024
- **LABOR DAY:** Monday, September 2, 2024
