

El Paso County Holiday Leave



In accordance with the County's Holiday Policy: In the event a holiday falls on Sunday, the following Monday shall be deemed to be the holiday. In the event the holiday falls on Saturday, the preceding Friday shall be deemed to be the holiday. In the event the scheduled holiday shall be moved to either a Friday or Monday and that day is already observed as another County holiday, the scheduled holiday shall be given on the next available business day.

MARTIN LUTHER KING DAY: Monday, January 15, 2024

PRESIDENT'S DAY: Monday, February 19, 2024

GOOD FRIDAY: Friday, March 29, 2024

CESAR CHAVEZ DAY: Monday, April 1, 2024

MEMORIAL DAY: Monday, May 27, 2024

JUNETEENTH: Wednesday, June 19, 2024

INDEPENDENCE DAY: Thursday, July 4, 2024
