



## Measure 2: Clearance Rates

**Definition:** The number of disposed cases as a percentage of the number of incoming cases.

**Analysis and Interpretation:** The clearance rate is a measure of the incoming cases a court receives in a quarter compared to the total cases disposed of during the same quarter. This measure portrays the court's ability to balance current caseload and incoming cases. A clearance rate of 100% represents a court that is disposing of the same number of cases it is receiving. Above 100% represents a court that is disposing of more cases than it is receiving. Below 100% represents a court that is disposing of fewer cases than it is receiving. This measure may be helpful in addressing case management decisions related to backlog. Several graphs are displayed below.

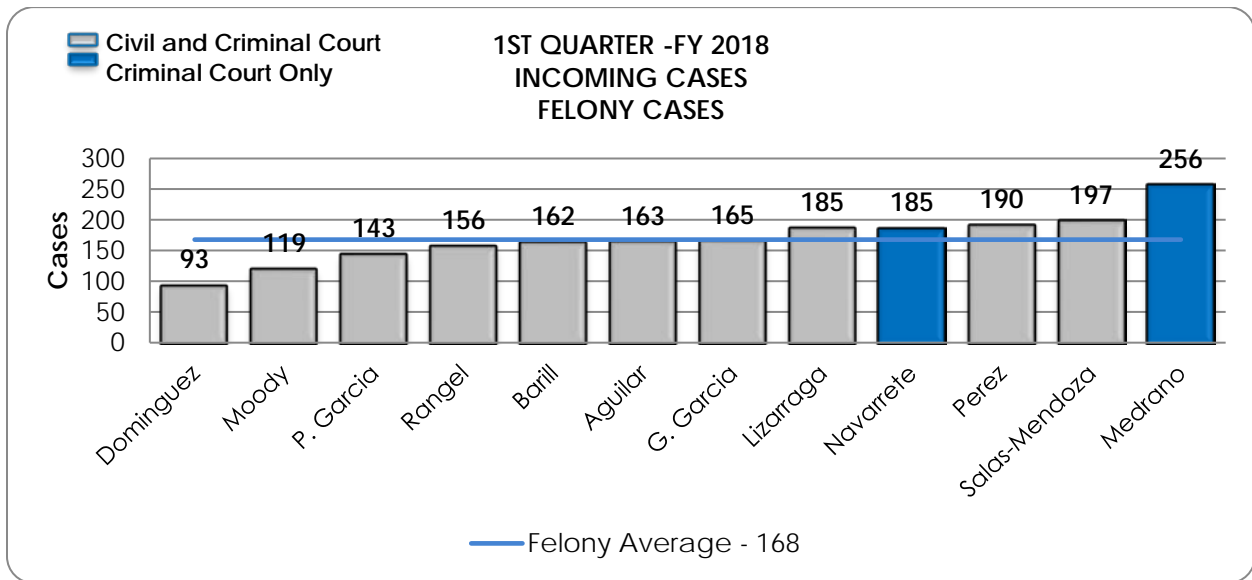
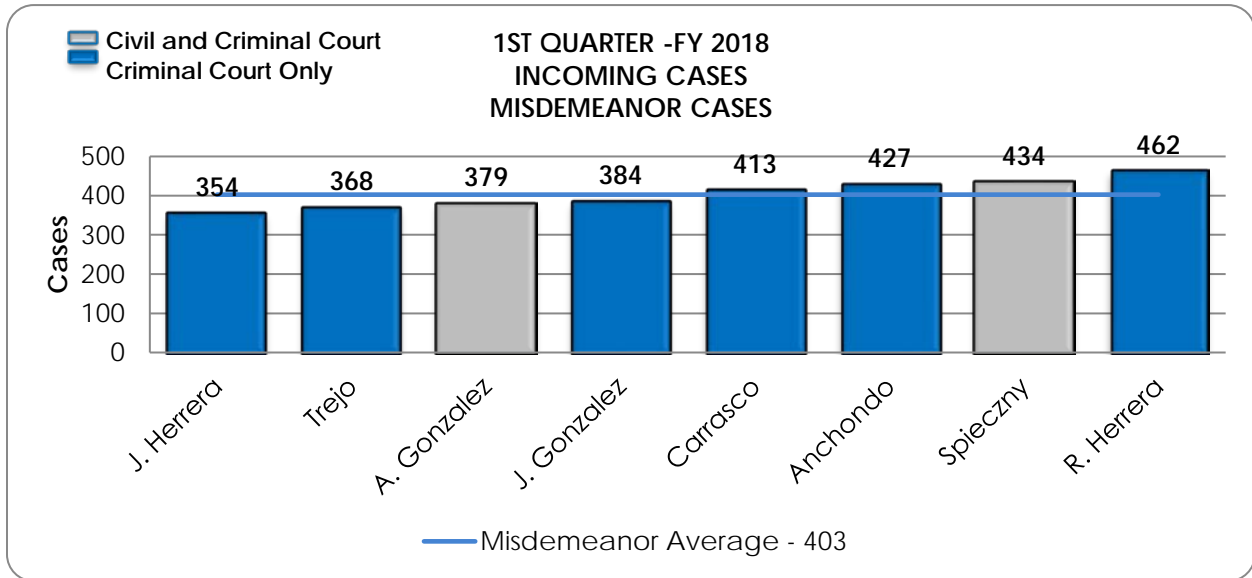
1. The first set of graphs show the number of **incoming cases**, which indicates the incoming workload.

3. The third set of graphs show the **clearance rate by court**.



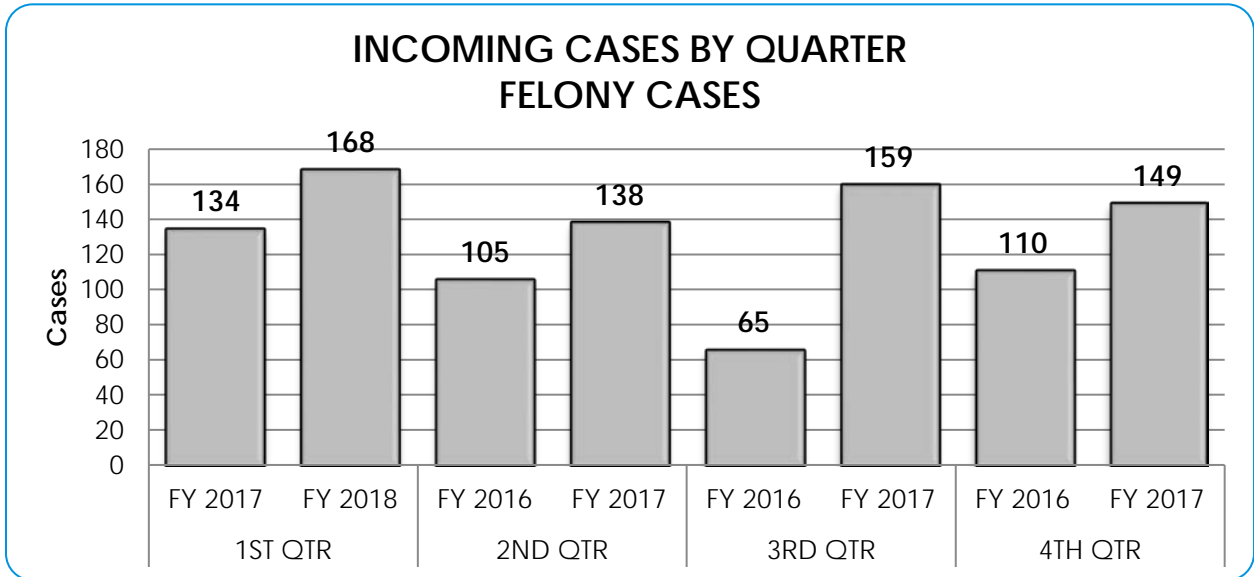
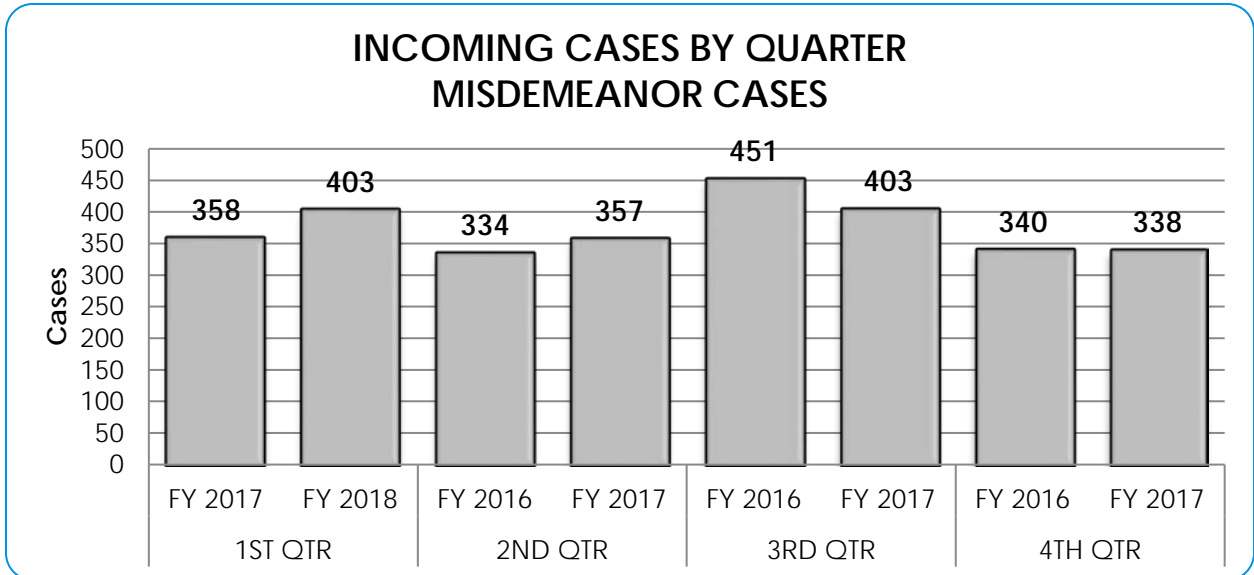

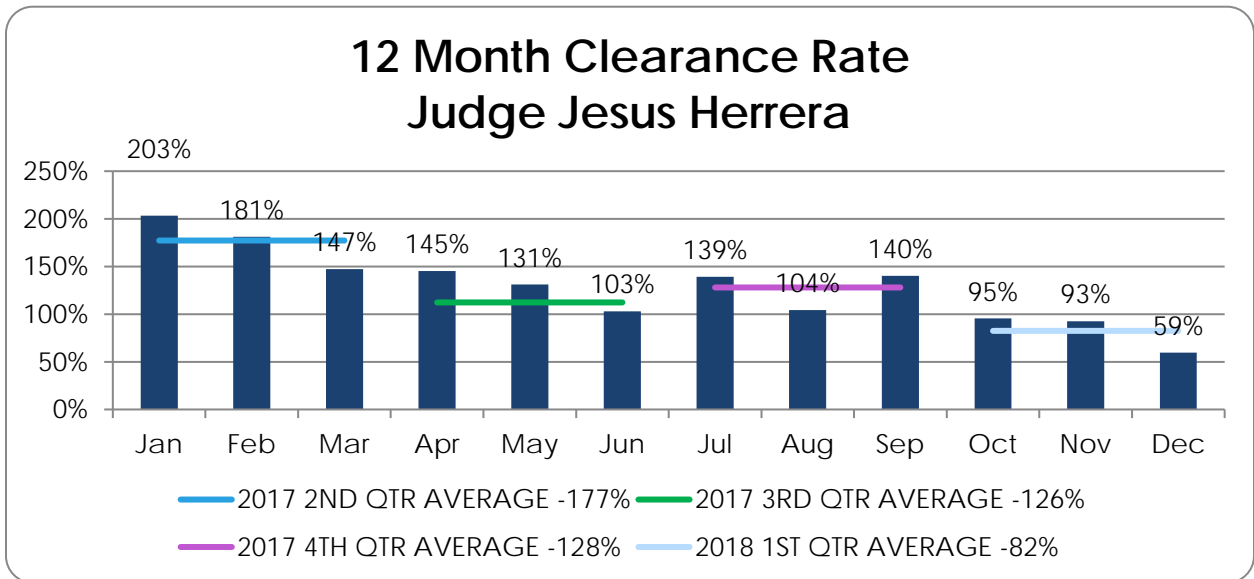
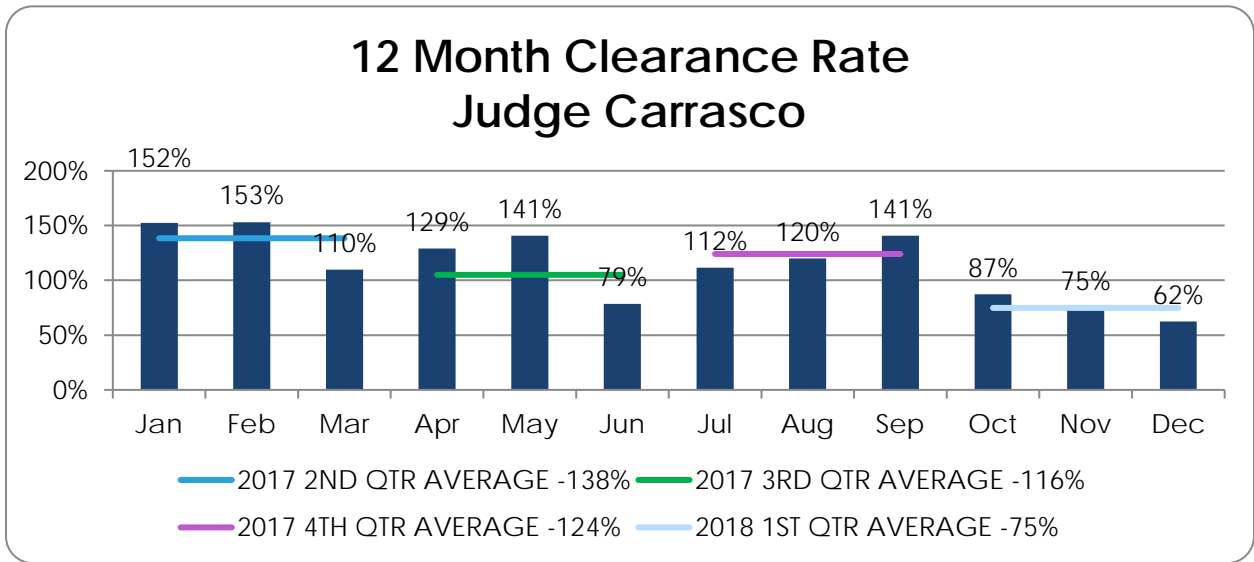
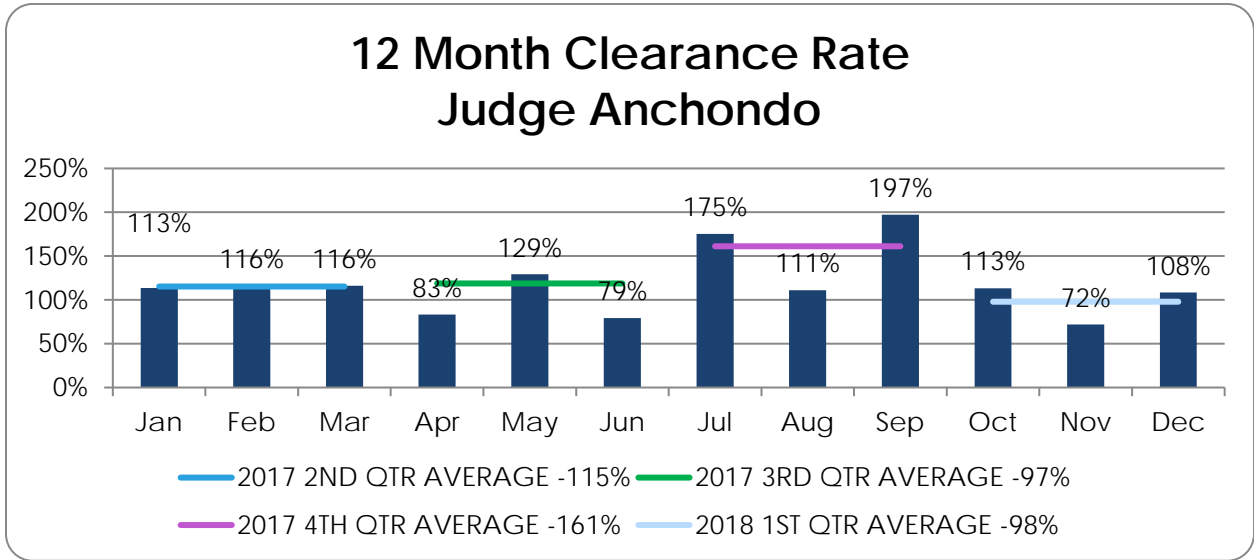
### 12 Month Clearance Rate Judge Spieczny

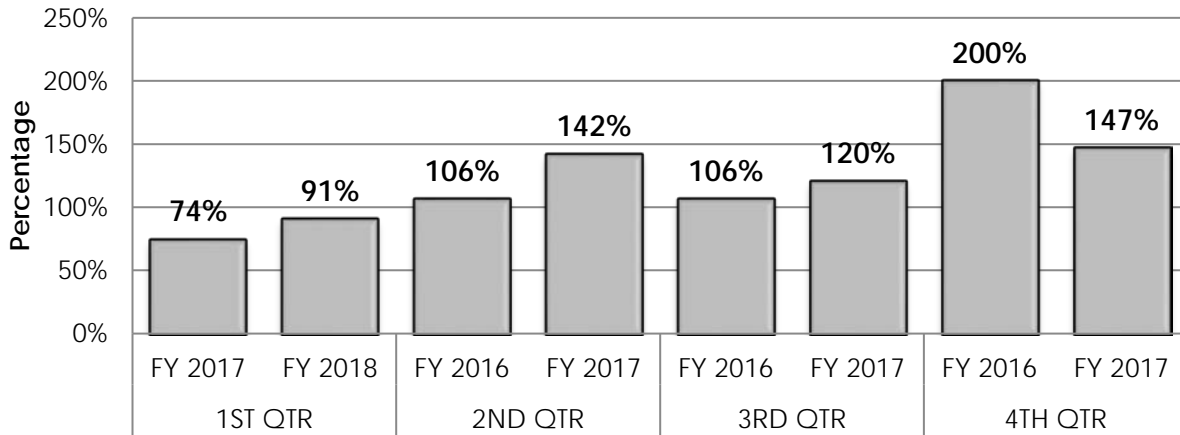

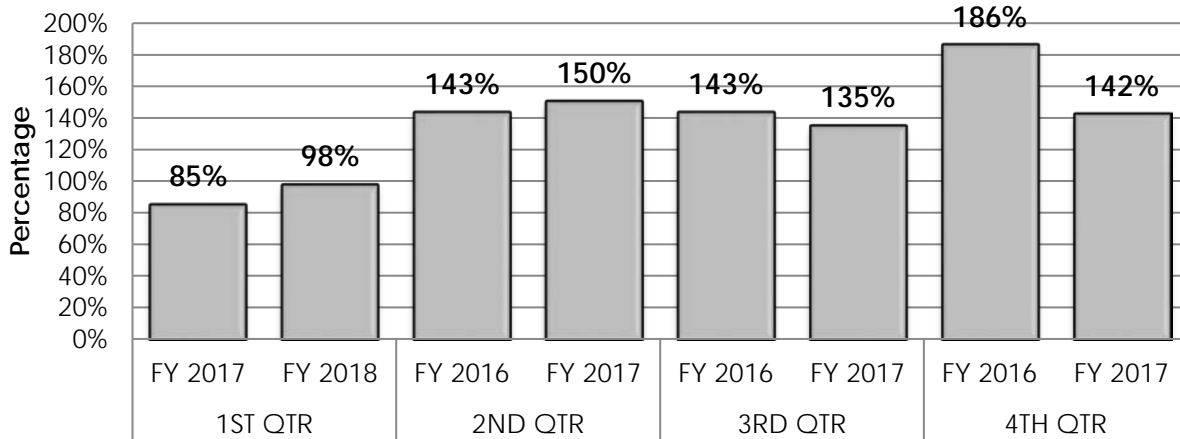
