

CONTRACTOR SERVICES AGREEMENT

This Agreement is entered into by and between the County of El Paso ("County"), a political subdivision of the State of Texas and National Medical Services (NMS) ("Contractor").

WHEREAS, the County issued Bid #09-034 to solicit bids for services to the El Paso County Medical Examiner's Office for toxicology services; and

WHEREAS, the Contractor was awarded the contract by the El Paso County Commissioners Court on June 22, 2009.

NOW, THEREFORE, the parties mutually agree as follows:

1. Scope of Services Performed by Contractor. Contractor will provide postmortem toxicology panels as follows:
 - a. Basic Postmortem Toxicology which consists of the Basic offering of drugs of abuse and alcohol, and the Expanded Postmortem Toxicology which includes the Basic Postmortem Toxicology package plus a predefined selection of over 350 current, relevant abused and therapeutic drugs or metabolites. Basic and Expanded Postmortem Toxicology services include:
 - Routine screening of both blood and urine with quantitative confirmation testing performed in blood
 - Routine turn around time of 7 business days from receipt of postmortem samples
 - Certifying scientist's review with computer generated report.
 - b. Additional testing for metals/metalloids, carboxyhemoglobins, and/or vitreous electrolytes includes:
 - Screening and quantitative confirmation testing for all compounds included in the scope of the panel
 - Toxicologist directed analysis based on provided case history
 - Typed analysis report with a Toxicologist's certification and signature if ordered in conjunction with traditional autopsy panels.
 - Toxicologist assistance with routine questions regarding interpretation
 - c. All testing includes:
 - Preprinted account requisition forms
 - Specimen collection/shipping kits

- Prepaid Federal Express shipping (standard overnight services)
- Forensic Client Support services available from 8:00 a.m. – 8:00 p.m. (EST)

2. Time of Performance. The duties of the Contractor shall commence on May 12, 2009 and terminate on May 11, 2010. This agreement may be renewed by the agreement of the parties, upon the same terms and conditions, for an additional one (1) year term, beginning on May 12, 2010. Contractor shall notify the County of its desire to renew this agreement not less than 60 days prior to its expiration. The County shall by action of the Commissioners Court, indicate its assent or rejection of Contractor’s request to renew this agreement.

3. Compensation and Method of Payment.

Price for testing each case regardless of amount of specimens:

If the County requests any testing that is not listed above, County agrees to pay the price listed in the 2009 NMS Fee Schedule issued on March 1, 2009.

Contractor shall submit invoices for all services rendered to the Medical Examiner. County shall pay Contractor within thirty (30) days following receipt of each invoice. Any penalties or interest for late payment must comply with Chapter 2251 of the Texas Government Code.

4. Independent Contractor. Contractor is an independent contractor, and neither Contractor nor Contractor's staff is, or shall be deemed, County's employees. In its capacity as an independent contractor, Contractor agrees and represents, and County agrees, as follows:

(a) Contractor will furnish all equipment and materials used to provide the services required by this agreement.

(b) The services required by this agreement shall be performed by Contractor and County shall not be required to hire, supervise or pay anyone to help Contractor.

(c) County shall not provide insurance coverage or benefits of any kind for Contractor or Contractor's employees.

(d) Contractor will pay all taxes arising by reason of Contractor's revenues hereunder, including all taxes upon property owned by Contractor.

5. Termination of Agreement. Either party has the right to terminate this agreement for any reason upon thirty (30) days written notice.

6. General Provisions.

(a) Sole agreement. This Agreement and the bid submitted by Contractor in Bid #09-034 (to include the 2009 NMS Fee Schedule), which is incorporated herein, contain the entire agreement between Contractor and County. If there exists a conflict between this Agreement and bid, this Agreement governs.

(b) Severability. If any part of this agreement is held unenforceable, the rest of the agreement will continue in full force and effect.

(c) Applicable law. This agreement will be governed by the laws of the State of Texas and venue shall be El Paso County, Texas.

(d) Notices. All notices and other communications given in connection with this agreement shall be in writing and shall be deemed given as follows:

Notices shall be deemed given when delivered personally to the recipient's address, or three days after being deposited in the United States mail, postage prepaid to the recipient's address.

(e) Assignment: Contractor may not assign its rights or obligations under this agreement without County's prior written consent.

(f) Amendment. Except as authorized in (g) below, this agreement may not be amended or modified except by a writing executed by both parties hereto.

(g) In the event any federal or state legislative and/or regulatory changes impact Contractor's laboratory testing business, Contractor will retain the right, upon prior written notice to County, to immediately amend this agreement to fully comply with any legislation or regulatory changes.
