*WHEREAS, Castner Range is located in a mountainous area of El Paso County and is owned by the United States Government (the "U.S."); and,*

*WHEREAS, the Commissioners' Court wishes that the land be preserved and not developed, and wishes to request that the U.S. Department of the Army work to achieve a Conservation Conveyance so that the whole of Castner Range is preserved and no portion is developed so that it can be used by the public for passive recreational use.*

*NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the El Paso County Judge and Commissioners' Court advocates the preservation of Castner Range for future generations and that it not be developed in whole or in part.*
