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The Purchasing Department received questions relating to the above referenced proposal; the response to the following question:

**1. Will we be able to examine the existing conditions of the subject openings? Whom do we need contact to set up as site visit?**

**2. Are you looking for a General Contractor to bid the project or a Turn-Key Commercial Door Subcontractor? Or either? As long as all permits, bonding, licenses etc. are met.**

- The contractor shall perform services for the County of El Paso as identified in the County's Request for Bid.
- All work conducted shall conform to all applicable building, mechanical, plumbing, fire and electrical codes and regulations.
- If portions of the work cannot be performed by the contractor, the contractor shall ensure that the work will be conducted by licensed technicians. For example: In order to comply with National Electrical Code and fire protection rules and regulations, the contractor may have to hire licensed specialists to complete some of the work required for this project.

- The contractor shall obtain all necessary permits and licenses.
- The Contractor does not have authority to enter into contracts on behalf of the County.
- The Contractor is an independent contractor, and neither the Contractor nor Contractor's staff is, or shall be deemed, county employees.

**3. Are you concerned with matching all existing hardware manufacturer's products or just the existing key system?**

No, we are not concerned to match existing hardware or manufacturer's products. However, the listed conditions shall be met:

All doors shall be key lockable to MIWA CY keyway and lockable from both sides. The maintenance section will provide the required key codes. In addition, the outer doors shall be equipped with magnetic locking devices.

The color and appearance of the new doors and storefront shall match closely the first floor windows and frames.

**4. Will Apprenticeship be required on this project?**

No, an apprenticeship program is not required for this project.
