2. Do you have an estimated amount (Engineer Estimate) for the project referenced below? Therefore, the bid bond can be procured. Please advise.

Response: There is no budget for this project. Interested vendor will need to determine if bond is required based on their Price Sheet response. Interested vendor should refer to page 2 and pages 19-20 of the specifications for requirements.

As stated on page 2 of the specifications, if the contract is for the construction of public works or is under a contract exceeding \$100,000 the bidder shall furnish a good and sufficient Bid Bond in the amount of 5% of the total contract price executed with a surety company authorized to do business in the State of Texas and must be included in the bid package. A cashier's check may be provided in lieu of a bid bond and made payable to the order of County of El Paso. Successful bidder must comply with all performance bond, payment bond, and insurance certificate requirements.
