INTERMEDIATE USE OF FORCE IN A JAIL SETTING: (16 hrs) TCLEOSE 3504. This course is a TCLEOSE Requirement for Intermediate Jailer Certification . This course will teach the student how to recognize circumstances which justify use of force to subdue inmate or defend self and how to determine when use of force can be considered excessive. FAMILY VIOLENCE AND SEXUAL ASSAULT: (4 hrs) TCLEOSE 3939 This course is an advanced training on family violence and sexual assault. It will help law enforcement officers recognize better procedures when dealing with victims of sexual assault or family violence. Mandatory for all El Paso County Sheriff's Office detectives, deputies, and dispatch. SEXUAL ASSAULT FAMILY VIOLENCE INVESTIGATOR COURSE: (24 hrs) TCLEOSE 3264 The Academy will be hosting SAFVIC, which is designed to provide law enforcement officers around the state with the tools they need to effectively investigate and prevent sexual assault and family violence. This course is designed to satisfy the legislatively mandated course of Special Investigative Topics (3232). Instructor will be responsible for reporting TCLEOSE credit. Coordinator: R. CALEA standards require employees working in the law enforcement divisions to attend refresher training on CALEA prior to the re-accreditation, during the self-assessment phase. The student will also be able to discuss the search warrant requirements, and explain the procedures for obtaining a search warrant among other topics dealing with arrest, search and seizure. <p align="center">E-Training</p> <p>INTERMEDIATE INMATE SUICIDE DETECTION AND PREVENTION IN A JAIL SETTING: (8 hrs) TCLEOSE 3501 <u>This course is a TCLEOSE requirement for Intermediate Jailer Certification.</u> The training will help the officer to take a proactive approach to identifying and preventing suicidal attempts in a jail setting. The course will make the officer aware of potential liabilities that may occur when suicides are successful in a facility. PHYSICAL FITNESS REQUIREMENT

** Some courses offered by the El Paso County Sheriff's Office

Region VIII Training Academy will require a degree of physical fitness.

- **Minimum Level-** This level will consist of walking, stepping, and very light cardiovascular exercise.
- **Medium Level-** This level will consist of jogging, minimal levels of calisthenics i.e. push-ups, sit-ups, side straddle hop, beginning levels of hands on classes i.e. PPCT and O.C.
- **Maximum Level-** This level will consist of running, sprinting, advanced calisthenics, advanced levels of hands on classes i.e. mobile field force, physical fitness exams.
- **Medium and maximum-** levels will require a blood pressure screening and students who do not pass will not be allowed to participate without a doctor's release on file.
