In most cases, the voter approval tax rate is the highest tax rate a taxing unit can adopt without holding an election. In each case, these rates are calculated by dividing the total amount of taxes by the current taxable value with adjustments as required by state law. The rates are given per \$100 of property value. 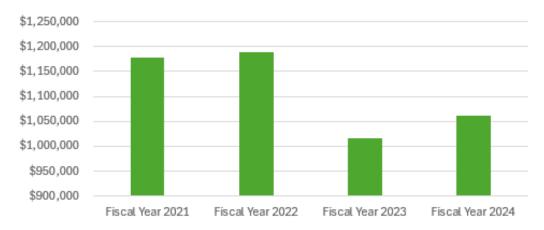

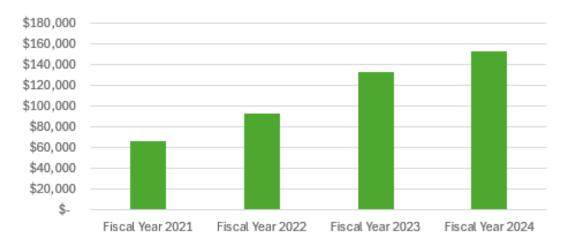

Description

A fee is imposed on the amount of or value of bingo pries within the County of El Paso. The Texas Lottery Commission (TLC collects this fee and subsequently redistributes it to the County. Bingo prize needs to be more than \$5.00 to collect 5.00% of the amount. Effective Jan. 1, 2020, H.B. 914 changes the collection and remittance of prize fees. Local governments will no longer receive their bingo prize fee payments from the TLC at the end of the fiscal year; instead, the licensed organizations conducting bingo in the local jurisdiction will be responsible for sending eligible local governments 50% of the prize fees they collect on a quarterly basis. The County Tax Office collects these revenues.

In 1996, Texas filed a federal lawsuit accusing the tobacco industry of violating conspiracy, racketeering, consumer protection, and other provisions of state and federal law. The state sought to recover billions of tax dollars it had spent to treat tobacco-related illnesses. In settling the lawsuit, the industry agreed to pay the state \$15 billion over 25 years and to pay about \$2.3 billion through 2003 to Texas counties and hospital districts based on their provision of indigent health care. Actual payments by the industry are subject to adjustment formulas related to tobacco sales, inflation, and industry profitability. Under Texas' settlement terms, payments from the industry rise or fall in proportion to U.S. consumption of cigarettes each year as compared to consumption in 1997.

(a) A defendant convicted of a felony or a misdemeanor shall pay the following reimbursement fees for services performed in the case by a peace officer: (1) \$5 for issuing a written notice to appear in court following the defendant's violation of a traffic law, municipal ordinance, or penal law of this state, or for making an arrest without a warrant;(2) \$50 for executing or processing an issued arrest warrant, capias, or capias pro fine, with the fee imposed for the services of: (A) the law enforcement agency that executed the arrest warrant or capias, if the agency requests of the court, not later than the 15th day after the date of the execution of the arrest warrant or capias, the imposition of the fee on conviction; or (B) the law enforcement agency that processed the arrest warrant or capias, if: (i) the arrest warrant or capias was not executed; or (ii) the executing law enforcement agency failed to request the fee within the period required by Paragraph (A); (3) \$5 for summoning a witness; (4) \$35 for serving a writ not otherwise listed in this article;(5) \$10 for taking and approving a bond and, if necessary, returning the bond to the courthouse; (6) \$5 for commitment or release (7) \$5 for summoning a jury, if a jury is summoned; and (8)\$8 for each day's attendance of a prisoner in a habeas corpus case if the prisoner has been remanded to custody or held to bail.

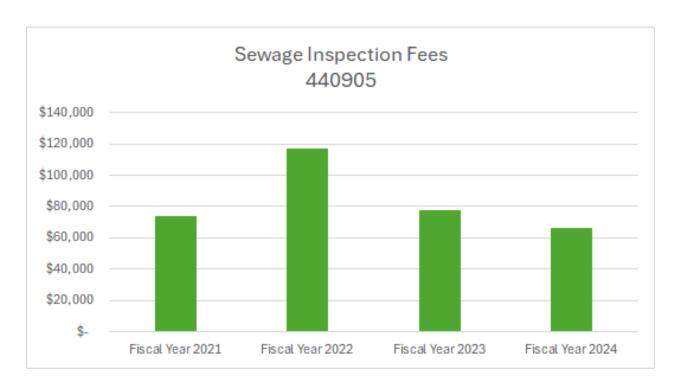

Art. 42A.651. PAYMENT AS CONDITION OF COMMUNITY SUPERVISION. (a) A judge may not order a defendant to make a payment as a term or condition of community supervision, except for: (1) the payment of fines, court costs, or restitution to the victim; (2) reimbursement of a county as described by Article 42A.301(b)(11); or (3) a payment ordered as a condition that relates personally to the rehabilitation of the defendant or that is otherwise expressly authorized by law. (b) A defendant's obligation to pay a fine or court cost as ordered by a judge is independent of any requirement to pay the fine or court cost as a condition of the defendant's community supervision. A defendant remains obligated to pay any unpaid fine or court cost after the expiration of the defendant's period of community supervision. (c) A judge may not impose a condition of community supervision requiring a defendant to reimburse a county for the costs of legal services as described by Article 42A.301(b) (11) if the defendant has already satisfied that obligation under Article 26.05(g).

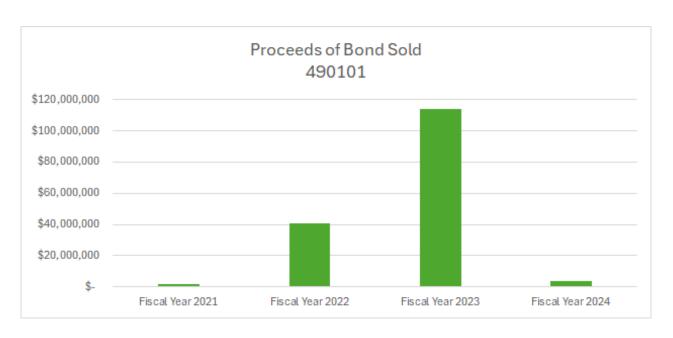
Texas Department of Insurance (TDI) does not regulate forms, rules or rates for bail bonds. Chapter 2301, Subchapter A (formerly Article 5.13-2), Texas Insurance Code, specifically exempts from regulation criminal court appearance bonds. Occupations Code, Chapter 1704 - Regulation of Bail Bond Sureties, requires mandatory creation of a Bail Bond Board (board) in counties with a population of 110,000 or more and discretionary creation of a board in a county with a population of less than 110,000. The board is responsible for the licensing of bail bond sureties and agents regardless of whether the agents use their nonexempt real property as security or act on behalf of a corporate surety (insurance company).

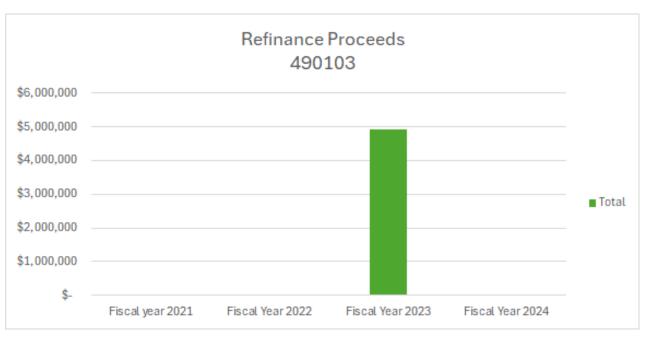
