Affidavit For Correction of a Marriage License

If you notice an error on your Texas marriage license, you can correct it using a notarized Affidavit of Correction.

1. Identify the Error

Determine exactly what part of the recorded marriage license is incorrect.

2. Complete the Affidavit

Both parties must sign a notarized affidavit that includes:

- Full names of both parties
- Date of marriage
- The error on the license
- The corrected information

3. Notarize the Affidavit

Both parties sign the affidavit in front of a notary public.

4. Submit to the County Clerk

- File the affidavit with the county clerk where the original license was recorded.
- The clerk will record it as an amendment to the marriage license.
- Filing fee: \$17.00 for the affidavit of correction.

Legal Reference:

- Texas Family Code § 2.209 (c) – Authorizes the use of a notarized affidavit to correct errors on a marriage license: Texas Constitution and Statutes

Note: The affidavit becomes part of the official marriage record once filed.
