STANDING ORDER ON E-FILING

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that:

All parties and counsel appearing before the 210th District Court shall provide the Court with a copy of any electronic filing that requires a hearing or other court action along with the request for hearing or other court action. This includes, but is not limited to:

1. motion for substituted service;
2. entry of appearance;
3. cross claims and counterclaims;
4. amended pleadings (petitions, answers, etc.)
5. motion to transfer venue;
6. special exceptions;
7. motion to dismiss pursuant to Rule 91a;
8. motion to compel discovery;
9. motion to compel arbitration;
10. motion to abate;
11. plea to the jurisdiction;
12. motion for summary judgment;
13. motion to dismiss;
14. notice of non-suit; and
15. motion for new trial.
