Attorney Reporting Portal Due by October 15, 2014 from Attorneys Who Accept Appointments in Adult Criminal and Juvenile Delinquency Cases

Attorney Reporting Instructions & Form (For use ONLY if county accepts hard copy submissions)

Indigent Defense Expenditure Report Manual for FY 14 Reports Due on November 3, 2014 Today the Texas Indigent Defense Commission with our partners at Texas A&M University's Public Policy Research Institute is launching the attorney reporting portal at https://tidc.tamu.edu/attorneyreporting. This portal will facilitate implementation of Article 26.04(j)(4), Code of Criminal Procedure, which requires that all attorneys handling indigent criminal and juvenile delinquency cases report the percentage of their practice time devoted to such cases for the previous 12 month period (October 1-September 30) in each county. If your county is one in which the judges through their indigent defense plans have directed the attorneys to report through this portal, we encourage you to let them know that the system is now open and available to complete the report; perhaps by forwarding this newsletter. There is also a new Attorney Report that county and court officials can view when logged into the Commission's data and plan website to see the reports provided by attorneys in your jurisdiction.

If your county requires attorneys to report to the county directly, then now would be a great time to share the form for doing so with the attorneys, as well as to whom they should submit the report. It can be found on the Commission's website at http://www.tidc.texas.gov/media/2157/DefenseAttyReportingInstructionsFormv3.pdf. As a reminder, the information from this form must then be compiled by the county and reported to the Commission by November 1st. We have created a means to do this as part of the Indigent Defense Expenditure Report (IDER). The IDER manual has a new section on pages 13-15 with information on the process and a link to a template on which the attorney reports may be compiled and submitted.

Either way it is to be submitted, the statement must describe: (1) the percentage of an attorney's total practice time that was dedicated to work on trial and appeal appointments in adult criminal cases in each county's district and county courts during the prior fiscal year; (2) the percentage of an attorney's total practice time that was dedicated to work on trial and appeal appointments in juvenile delinquency cases (cases alleging delinquent conduct or conduct indicating a need for supervision) in each county's district and county courts during the prior fiscal year; and (3) the method an attorney used for calculating the practice time figures. The practice time figures should not include time dedicated to work on appointments to cases (such as CPS cases and guardianship cases) that are not adult criminal or juvenile delinquency cases, and they should not include time dedicated to federal criminal appointments.

There is an optional Attorney Practice Time <u>Worksheet</u> available to assist attorneys in calculating these percentage figures. It provides a tool to help attorneys consider all of the types of cases they handle when calculating the percentage of time spent on criminal and juvenile appointed work. In addition to the link above it is also available on the attorney portal at the time an attorney is preparing to submit their practice time report.
