El Paso County Officials Host Capital Finance Community Meetings

EL PASO, TX – The El Paso County Capital Planning Department will host a series of community meetings beginning January 11th to discuss the County’s ongoing Capital Finance Plan for FY2023. On December 12th, Commissioners Court voted to start the financing process in the amount of \$100 million to be used on critical public safety and essential public infrastructure project needs. The proposed finance plan is not projected to raise the County’s current tax rate and continues the Commissioners Court’s efforts to reduce the County tax rate beginning in 2021.
