

## COMMISSIONERS COURT PUBLIC COMMENT

Members of the public may address Commissioners Court during the Public Comment section or during any particular agenda item of the meeting. Any inquiries made by the public must be specific questions, which may be briefly answered with a statement of specific factual information.

The public may speak regarding an Agenda item or, pursuant to Texas Government Code Section 551.042, raise a subject that has <u>not</u> been included in the Agenda.

Speaking time limits will be observed. During Public Comment, the speaking time limit is five (5) minutes. During discussion of an agenda item, the speaking time limit is three (3) minutes per person. Time cannot be delegated from one speaker to another.
