

**Access and Possession
Facilitation**

Goal: To assist parents in arriving to an agreement concerning a schedule for parenting time of the non-custodial parent in order to prevent or decrease litigation.

1. Attend Orientation and Cooperative Parenting classes.
2. Individual/joint interviews will be conducted.
3. Must fill out Access Facilitation questionnaire.
4. If parents/parties reach an agreement, they will sign an **Agreed Access and Possession Schedule** which will be presented to their Attorneys and to the court to be signed.
5. If an agreement is not reached, an observation with the non-custodial parent and the child/ren might be scheduled.
6. A Report to the Court will be filed and provided to the court and to the attorneys or parties when the parents/parties do not reach an agreement.
