What is a Comprehensive Master Plan?

A plan for the future. The County is working to develop a strategic vision for the County's Historic Mission Trail Area which involves your input. The plan will boost economic development and helps the Mission Valley potentially receive a UNESCO World Heritage site designation.

What is a UNESCO World Heritage site?

A recognized area of cultural or historical significance of outstanding universal value. Recognized sites have a worldwide identity, are protected by international treaties, and qualify for funds from a global body for the sites protection and conservation.

What is a Charrette?

A Charrette is rapid, intensive, and includes a series of creative work sessions between the public and the design team to produce a draft plan for the future.

Participating in the Charrette will give you a chance to express your vision for the future of the El Paso Mission Trail. Your participation will make the difference between a good plan and a great one.
