WHEREAS, "National Preparedness Month" creates an important opportunity for every resident of El Paso County to prepare their homes, businesses, and communities for any type of emergency from natural disasters to potential terrorist attacks; and

WHEREAS, investing in the preparedness of ourselves, our families, businesses, and communities can reduce fatalities and economic devastation in our communities and in our nation; and

WHEREAS, the Office of Emergency Management, El Paso Citizen Corps, Ready El Paso, El Paso Voluntary Organizations Active in Disaster (VOAD) and other federal, state, local, private, and volunteer agencies are working to increase public activities in preparing for emergencies and to educate individuals on how to take action; and

WHEREAS, emergency preparedness is the responsibility of every citizen of El Paso County and all citizens are urged to make preparedness a priority and work together, as a team, to ensure that individuals, families, and communities are prepared for disasters and emergencies of any type; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the El Paso County Judge and Commissioners Court hereby proclaim September, 2010 as

NATIONAL PREPAREDNESS MONTH

and encourages all citizens and businesses to pledge to prepare by developing their own emergency preparedness plan, taking part in preparedness training, and working together toward creating a more prepared society.
