The following notes are provided regarding special considerations and activities of the office during this reporting period:

- Precinct 2 continues to spearhead the legislative efforts, Odyssey transition, E-Citation, and in-car computer dispatch systems on behalf of the Constables throughout the county.
- Constable Gammon was appointed President of the West Texas JPCA at its annual meeting held in Wichita Falls in April. In addition, Deputy Espinosa was re-appointed to the Board of Directors for the association, and Deputy Marcos Chavez from Precinct 3 Constable Hector Bernal's office was recognized as Deputy of the Year for the association, upon recommendation of Constable Gammon.
- The next West Texas JPCA Conference will be held in El Paso in April 2012, hosted by Constable Gammon and a committee of staff members from throughout Justices of the Peace and Constable offices here in El Paso County.
- Despite lack of personnel and growing caseloads, Precinct 2 continues to perform well at civil and criminal process service, and continues to generate modest revenue on warrant collections without the benefit of a warrants deputy to perform field work.
