#### **SUBJECT:**

Approve the recommendation from the El Paso County Staffing Review Committee to approve Request #2012-019 to reinstate the frozen Internal Auditor position (PM-5) for the Auditor's Office effective 4/16/12 at a budget impact of \$23,534 for Fiscal Year 2012 and authorize the department to fill the vacancy.

#### BACKGROUND/DISCUSSION OF TOPIC:

On October 3, 2011, Commissioners Court adopted the hiring freeze & personnel staffing review policy for FY2012. The policy provides for the committee to review personnel staffing requests from departments.

The committee met on April 9, 2012 and reviewed Request #2012-019 from the County Auditor's Office regarding the unfreezing of an Internal Auditor position.

The Auditor's Office is currently working with the Information Technology Department on the migration to and implementation of the Odyssey program throughout the County. The Auditor's Office does not have the staff in place to have an employee dedicated to focus on this program full time, and thus the department does not have the ability to use Odyssey to its fullest capacity. This Internal Auditor would serve as a liaison between ITD and the user departments. This Internal Auditor would also focus on other implementation projects as they come up, which will include a new payroll system in the near future. The Auditor's Office and the Committee agreed that the Odyssey Project is a large investment that can potentially fail if the correct support staff is not in place.

Additionally, staff from the County Auditor's Office confirmed that there would be a budget impact of \$23,534 to fund this position. The committee's legal advisor found no legal issues with this request. The justification was reviewed by members of the committee as well. The committee recommends approving the waiver based on the circumstances and the information provided.

#### **SUBJECT:**

Approve the recommendation from the El Paso County Staffing Review Committee to approve Request #2012-021 to reinstate a frozen Collection Specialist (GS-11) position to assist with backlogged cases and to work with Scofflaw cases for the County Clerk's Office for a budget impact of \$14,885 and authorize the department to fill the vacancy.

#### **BACKGROUND/DISCUSSION OF TOPIC:**

On October 3, 2011, Commissioners Court adopted the hiring freeze & personnel staffing review policy for FY2012. The policy provides for the committee to review personnel staffing requests from departments.

The committee met on April 9, 2012 and reviewed Request #2012-021 from the County Clerk's Office regarding the unfreezing of a Collection Specialist position.

The County Clerk's Office currently has an overwhelming number of cases as well as a backlog of cases inherited from the District Clerk's Office. There are currently 5,756 backlogged Child Support, Jury Contempt and Protective cases that take between 35-50 minutes each to complete. Additionally, there are the current cases that need to be completed. HR and the Auditor's Office each conducted an independent Job Analysis and estimated that it would take 2 years for 5 Collection Specialists each working 1 day a week on the backlogged cases to catch up. To complete the project in the least amount of time, it is recommended that a Collection Specialist position be unfrozen and filled to exclusively complete this project. In addition, 5 current Collection Specialists will rotate for 1 day a week to work on the backlog and in this way the project will be completed in 1 year. The Collection Specialist position will be pulled to work on Scofflaw cases once the backlogged cases are completed.

Staff from the County Auditor's Office confirmed that there would be a budget impact of \$14,885 to fund this position for this fiscal year. The committee's legal advisor found no legal issues with this request. The justification was reviewed by members of the committee as well. The committee recommends approving the waiver based on the circumstances and the information provided.
