Accomplishments:

Pct. 7 participated in the following:

- Multiagency warrants round-up.
- Weekly meetings in the JOIC Center
- Gang Monthly

Pct. 7 continues with the C-Step program. (Constable's Special Traffic Enforcement Program) With the assistance of the infomercials, there have been a high volume of calls requesting speed enforcement in neighborhoods.

The Sheriff's Department and Constable Pct. 7 are working in a more united way in the area of equine rescue and enforcement.

There were two calls for assistance from the S.O from equine rescue this reporting period.

Warrant Recovery

The current situation with the inability of the courts to produce warrants has created a situation where payments of warrants has decreased significantly and the booking of individuals on old and pending warrants has increased dramatically.

Year to date cash recovery FY 2012: \$119,218.00
