The County of El Paso is formally requesting that funds from Operation Stonegarden 2011 be re-allocated from the Socorro Police Department to the El Paso County Sheriff's Office. The re-allocated funds will be available for the same categories as originally requested, overtime/benefits and fuel. The Socorro Police Department has not used the funds since they are under investigation. We believe it is in the public's best interest that these funds are available to work more hours protecting our borders. Thus, this change will be noted on the next quarterly operation plan that will be submitted for approval for the months of April-June 2013.

The total amount is \$24,415.00. The amount used for overtime/benefits will be \$18,537.40 and the remaining \$5,877.60 will be used for fuel.

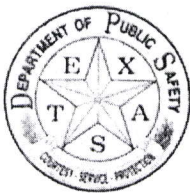
