As requested by Commissioners Court and County Auditors, the Constable's Department Precinct 1 is submitting this quarterly which reflects the criminal and civil activity for the months of April-June, 2013. The total amount submitted, is the combination of civil process fees and warrant fees on the civil report. The total amounts on the criminal report are the activity conducted by the Constable and the full-time deputies for Precinct 1. In my department, the Constable and deputies concentrate on the warrants, civil process and assisting as Bailiff's in the Justice of the Peace Court Pct. 1. I also gave you a break down on the officer's performance measures in executing warrants and civil process. Deputy Constables F. Almada, Deputy R. Martinez and C. Renteria assisted the State Comptroller's Office in several seizures during this quarter. Precinct One deputies also participated in the El Paso County Sheriff's DWI Warrant Round-up on May 28-30, 2013. During this Quarter the deputies from Pct. 1 collected a total of **\$ 16,643.00** in money orders. The deputies also booked subjects into the County Jail with **\$ 12,821.20** in Traffic Warrants, and **\$ 20,019.00** in non-traffic warrants. The stats were low due to the lack of warrants being issued due to flaws in the Odyssey system during this quarter. The stats for Pct. 1 should increase in the next Quarter due to warrants being issued and most flaws have been resolved in the Odyssey system. Deputy F. Almada has been out on FMLA for the month of June. I hope this gives the court and public some feedback in our progress and will also assist the County in evaluating our department's needs for future departmental budgetary requests. Precinct 1, has always strived to do what has been asked for by the court and will continue to do so to meet your goals and surpass our departmental goals.
