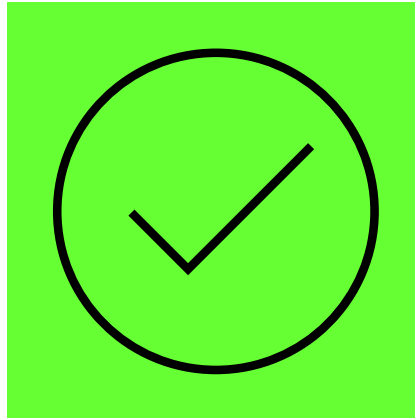
Free Community Cleanup Events

El Paso County

Is hosting a series of events designed to collect and dispose of household waste, passenger vehicle tires, bulk trash, electronic waste and recyclable materials. The events will be held on the Saturdays and locations shown on the back of this flyer. The collection event will begin at 8:00 am and will end at approximately 12:00 pm or until we have reached capacity (Whichever comes first).



This event is brought to you through the collaboration of the El Paso County, our great community partners and our Public Works Department. Building a better tomorrow, one block at a time.



What we will be Accepting:

-Passenger vehicle tires

- *Only 5 tires per resident
- *Tires 18 inches or smaller

-Bulk Trash & Electronic Waste:

One pickup truckload per resident. Items like furniture, chairs, carpet, tree branches, etc.

-Computers & Electronic Waste:

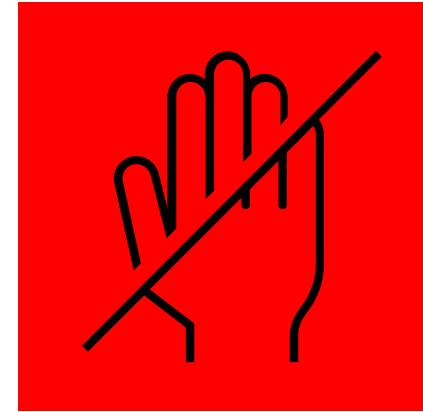
Computers, computer accessories, tablets, scanners, video games, cameras, radios, cellphones, VCRs and DVD players.

-Household Hazardous waste:

General cleaning agents, fertilizers, paints, oils, batteries, varnish, antifreeze, gasoline, tar and etc. (Maximum of three gallons per household will be accepted)

-Scrap Metal:

Scrap metal for recycling.



We will NOT Accept:

Commercial vehicle Tires:

- Tires from retailers
- Semi-Trucks or Equipment tires
- Tires with Rims
- Oversized vehicle tires

Bulk Trash & Electronic Waste:

- CRT Monitors and old tube televisions

Household Hazardous waste:

- Explosives or ammunitions, fireworks, compressed gases, radioactive waste, biomedical waste, business generated waste, hazardous waste, etc.

No Construction waste:
