The Purchasing Department received questions relating to the above referenced proposal.

1. Addendum 1 #1 states that the total of the two consoles is 72 inches in length, making each console 36" in length.

Correct.

2. The addendum also states in #5 that monitors can be stacked or in-line, but then also states in #13 that the monitors are 21" CRT's. CRT monitors can not be stacked, LCD monitors can however. Additionally, the bid document state on page 5 that work surfaces are to accommodate up to (7) 21" CRT monitors TOTAL. (7) 21" CRT's will not fit on the size of console specified. Please clarify:

3. Total number of monitors to be at each console:

Reduced to 6 from 7

4. Are these CRT or LCD monitors?

LCD

5. If the monitor requirements will not fit on a 36" length surface, can vendors propose a bigger console size or will it not fit in the space then?

6. In the bid docs, page 6 #15, #16, and #17, we are confused as to what you are referring to by 2-way connectors 53" high, 4-way connectors 53" high, and power entry direct connect 53" high? Can you please clarify what this is?

These connectors are what connect the panels together at the corners (must be of galvanized steel no exceptions)

7. Can vendors provide their standard warranty information or will this cause the bid to be rejected?

The cost of a 12 year warranty will cost more than the furniture itself (it would be cheaper to get new furniture than to pay for 12 year warranty) and is excessive for custom equipment.

No less than a 12 year warranty will be accepted (no exceptions) as stated in addendum #2 question 11

8. If the furniture is going to be installed at the existing Sheriff's Office as a live cutover, is there any furniture that will need to be torn down and disposed of by the vendor?

This will be an addition to the current Sheriff's Office Communications Center. No removal of equipment or furniture is necessary.

9. If yes, how many positions will be removed and will a dumpster be provided by the county or will the vendor need to provide this?
