The following materials will be provided by the County and installed by the contractor?

- 1. The following materials will be provided by the County and installed by the contractor?
  - The materials listed on the Bid- Document are the materials that will be provided by the homeowner for installation (materials are new).
  - If the company feels that it will need other material to complete the job then please have them describe in detail and include an itemized price ( material and labor)
- 2. Will you define top out and rough in and finish in regards to the bathroom.
  - Rough In Installation of water and waste pipes (will <u>NOT</u> be required has been done by homeowner.)
  - Top-Out Tie in of water and drain pipes
  - Finish Installation of all plumbing fixtures and accessories

- 3. What if it is not up to code on the rough in?
  - Contractor will need to comply only from the point where they will takeover, county, won't make them liable for all previous work performed.
    County is following the International Plumbing Code.
- 4. When it states new construction approximately 800 square feet home can you elaborate? See Attachment 1
  - Two homes are 23' x 31' consist of one (1) bathroom one (1) laundry area and one (1) kitchen.
  - One house is 30' x 30' also consist of one (1) bathroom, one (1) laundry area and one (1) kitchen.
