1. Is the Buy American Act form required? Can the Count y please provide the form?

Response: Yes it is required because it is a Federal funded project. Please see attachment 1 on our website at <a href="https://www.epcounty.com">www.epcounty.com</a>, click Bids & More; List of Bids.

2. Does the vendor need to fill out the Non-Collusion Affidavit form if they will not be using sub-contractors?

Response: Please see page 34, #5 in the bid packet.

3. If the vendor has already taken the Code of Ethics Training on line before, do they need to take it again?

Response: Please see page The Code of Ethics Training forms are provided in your bid packet. Please fill in and submit with your bid. This will suffice.

4. Does the vendor need to submit the Certificate of Interested Parties or after it is awarded?

Response: This form is required to be filled by the awarded vendor. Please see page 33 & 34, #4 in the bid packet.

5. Who will be doing the inspections?

Response: TX Dot and the County of El Paso will be doing the inspections.

6. When is the anticipated start date?

Response: As soon as it is awarded and contract is signed; approximately late July.

7. Is there a restriction on the working hours?

Response: Working hours are from 7:00 a.m.-4:00 p.m. Monday to Friday no overtime allowed, and excludes all County Holidays. There are also limitations to limiting deliveries during peak drop-off and peak pick-up hours when working near schools.

8. Can multiple construction phases be worked on concurrently?

Response: Phases are to be constructed sequentially as indicated on the plans. Multiple phases may be worked on concurrently, but will require prior approval from the Engineer and El Paso County.

9. Is the owner paying for the construction materials testing?

Response: Owner is responsible for construction materials testing.
