








El Paso Criminal Justice Mental Health Jail Diversion Collaboration

This collaboration for jail diversion of appropriate individuals diagnosed with brain disorders, is hereby entered into on the dates set out below by and between the agencies and entities indicated below through the formal execution of this agreement by the agency or entity, as evidenced by the respective signature of the agency or entity's authorized official at the end of this collaboration.

Jail diversion, both pre-arrest and post-arrest, of individuals diagnosed with a brain disorder in our community is considered a priority by these agencies and entities. We agree to work together to effect a coordinated response to such individuals on the verge of or already in the criminal justice system through the sharing of resources and information, mutual cooperation, program development and implementation, and joint grant applications.

Though each agency's views and perceptions of the problem and the appropriate response to the problem may differ, each agency recognizes the need to join together in order to effect a coordinated response to the increasing mental health population currently involved in our criminal justice system. To that end, each agency or entity, to the extent permitted by law, regulation and the mission of the agency or entity, commits to actively explore and implement ways to appropriately and safely redirect away from and out of the criminal justice system those individuals diagnosed with brain disorders whose actions or behavior are the result of their brain disorders.
