#### **Amigo Air Show**

The Sheriff's Office participated in the Air Show held at Biggs Army Airfield. The event was coordinated by Deputy Rogelio Arreola who supervised and assisted in the event. The event was held on Saturday October 16 from 9 a.m. to 5 p.m. and on Sunday October 17 from 9 a.m. to 5 p.m. The event included the El Paso County Sheriff's Office Command Post, SWAT Armored Truck, Search and Rescue Truck, 2 Search and Rescue Razors, Unit 1010, New F-150 1015, and the Classic 1953 Chevy Show Truck. The Recruiting Team was in attendance with Deputy Enrique Cortez and Detention Officer Carolina Perez who were ready to answer questions for future employees who were interested in working for the Sheriff's Office by passing out information pamphlets.
